GRADED TECHNIQUE- LEVELS I-V (BALLET, JAZZ, & TAP)

Our Graded Level Technique students build foundations in movement, vocabulary, technique, and choreography. All students in our Graded Technique Program participate in annual skills testing and optional parent-teacher conferences, as well as all recitals. ALL performance team members are required to enroll in the Relative Motion class, and there is a one-time fee for the class uniform (that can be re-used year after year). We are so excited to bring this program to Steps to Grace to help our dancers excel in their God-given talents, and to help them prevent dance-related injuries. All dancers are encouraged to take this unique class if they wish to excel in their dance technique.

HAIR & JEWELRY POLICY ALL CLASSES

Hair must be fully secured and completely out of the face for all classes (no half-up, half-down styles). Ballet classes require hair in a bun. Jewelry is not permitted in class, with the exception of small stud earrings. Dancers who do not follow these guidelines will be asked to adjust before class begins.

AGE-APPROPRIATE CLOTHING ALL CLASSES

We ask that all dancers wear modest, age-appropriate clothing to class. Bare midriffs and short shorts are not permitted. If a dancer arrives in clothing that doesn't meet these guidelines, they will be kindly asked to change before participating.

STUDIO POLICIES

Withdrawal Policy- When enrolling in classes at STG, you are signing up for the entire year (September-June). If you would like to withdraw from classes, you must notify the office no less than 30 days before the next billing cycle. There will be no exceptions to this policy.

Weather Closures- STG makes every effort to remain open during inclement weather, but we will not put our families or staff at risk in dangerous conditions. We update our Instagram and Facebook pages with any closures, and we send emails to all families before 2pm if we plan to close. If we close for bad weather more than THREE times, we will begin offering make-up sessions. Refunds will not be offered for weather closures. We are unable to send text messages when we close. Please keep a close eye on your email during weather events.

Absence Policy- STG does not offer refunds for any classes missed by your student for vacations, illnesses, or calendar conflicts. We allow students to attend TWO make-up classes in an equal level if they are absent twice. No make-up classes are offered beyond that. If there are injuries or other extenuating circumstances, we will evaluate those on a case-by-case basis. *If a teacher is absent, and a substitute can't be found, we will offer a make-up session for the missed class.*

Membership Fee- A yearly STG Membership Fee is charged upon enrollment, The fee for returning dancers is \$35.00, and new dancers are \$45.00. Membership fees for families with multiple dancers are discounted after the first child.

Tuition Payments- Steps to Grace classes each have a **yearly course fee**, and that fee is broken into ten equal monthly payments, the last of which is withdrawn **on June 1st**. Tuition is collected automatically on the 1st of each month (Sep., Oct., Nov., Dec., Jan., Feb., Mar., Apr., May, & Jun.). A credit or debit card must be on file for monthly auto-payments. No exceptions. We do not charge credit card fees. If your account is more than 60 days past-due, your dancer will not be allowed to attend classes until the balance is paid in full. This policy will be strictly enforced.

Tuition Discounts- 5% discounts are offered to first responders, church workers, and members of the military. We also offer sibling discounts of 5% for the second child and beyond. STG offers scholarships and tuition assistance on an as-needed basis. Please contact the office at kelly.stepstograce@gmail.com to have your discount applied, or to discuss our scholarship options. Discounts can't be combined.

COSTUME INFORMATION

Costume Fees- Costumes are purchased for ALL dancers for the **spring recital**, with the exception of Adult classes. Costume fees will be auto-collected in installments to make the cost more manageable for our families. Costume fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**, no exceptions. Most dancers DO NOT wear costumes during our Christmas recital. They wear class dress code attire and Steps to Grace provides accessories.

The first installment of costume payments will auto-process for most classes on October 15th.

The second installment of costume payments will auto-process for most classes on January 15th.

If your dancer enrolls AFTER January 1st, their entire costume payment will be due upon enrollment.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When is the first day of class? When is the last day of class? When is the studio closed for holidays?

Classes begin August 31, 2026 and end the Wednesday before Spring recital. All holidays and planned studio closures can be found on the calendar below.

When are Dress Rehearsals and Recitals? How much are show tickets? Dress rehearsals are held the day before or two days before each recital, and usually run between 3-10pm. Dancers will be assigned a “call time” to rehearse on stage, and are only required to be there during their call time. *On recital day, all dancers above age 3 are required to stay backstage for the ENTIRE show for their safety, and to maintain order during the performance. Students are not allowed to leave before the end of their show, so we ask you to block off your calendars for the entire recital day. Dress rehearsal times and show assignments are released 1-2 weeks beforehand. Show ticket prices are tiered based on seat selections, and they begin at \$17.00 each. Children ages 3 and under may sit in your lap for no charge. Parents that volunteer to help backstage receive one complimentary ticket to recital.

*December and June recital dates and locations are still being planned. Parents will be notified with details as soon as possible.

What do you do with my STG Membership fee? Membership fees hold your place in class, and are used to pay for our studio's insurance policies each year.

How do I watch my child while they are in class? We have large video monitors for each classroom in our lobby, and each room has a window available for viewing.

Am I allowed to be in the classroom with my dancer? We ask all parents to help their dancer enter and stay in the classroom independently, especially those ages 3 and up. They can see you through the windows during the entire class, and you are able to see them in the windows and through our video monitors. Instructors are able to help the dancers focus and work together to have an amazing class experience, and students gain confidence as they get to know their teacher and each other. Two-year old parents are welcome to attend class with their child, if desired, and are invited to participate on stage during our recitals if their dancer needs a little boost of confidence.

Tell me all about costumes! Bring on the glitter! Professional costumes are ordered throughout the year for dancers to wear in our SPRING recital. We stick to simple outfits and accessories for our Christmas show to keep costs down for our families, and to bring the focus in on the birth of our Savior as we perform. Students are measured by Steps to Grace staff members during every class, and costumes are ordered based on those measurements. Costume payment schedules can be found on our "Costume" page above, and those fees are auto-debited on the due date. ALL enrolled students will participate in both recitals, with the exception of Adult, Strength, and Art classes. *Costume fees are non-refundable.

Why is full tuition charged for a full month, even on the months we don't have 4 weeks of class?

Steps to Grace classes are all offered with a yearly “course fee”. Our course fees are split into TEN equal monthly payments, the last of which is auto-debited on June 1st.
