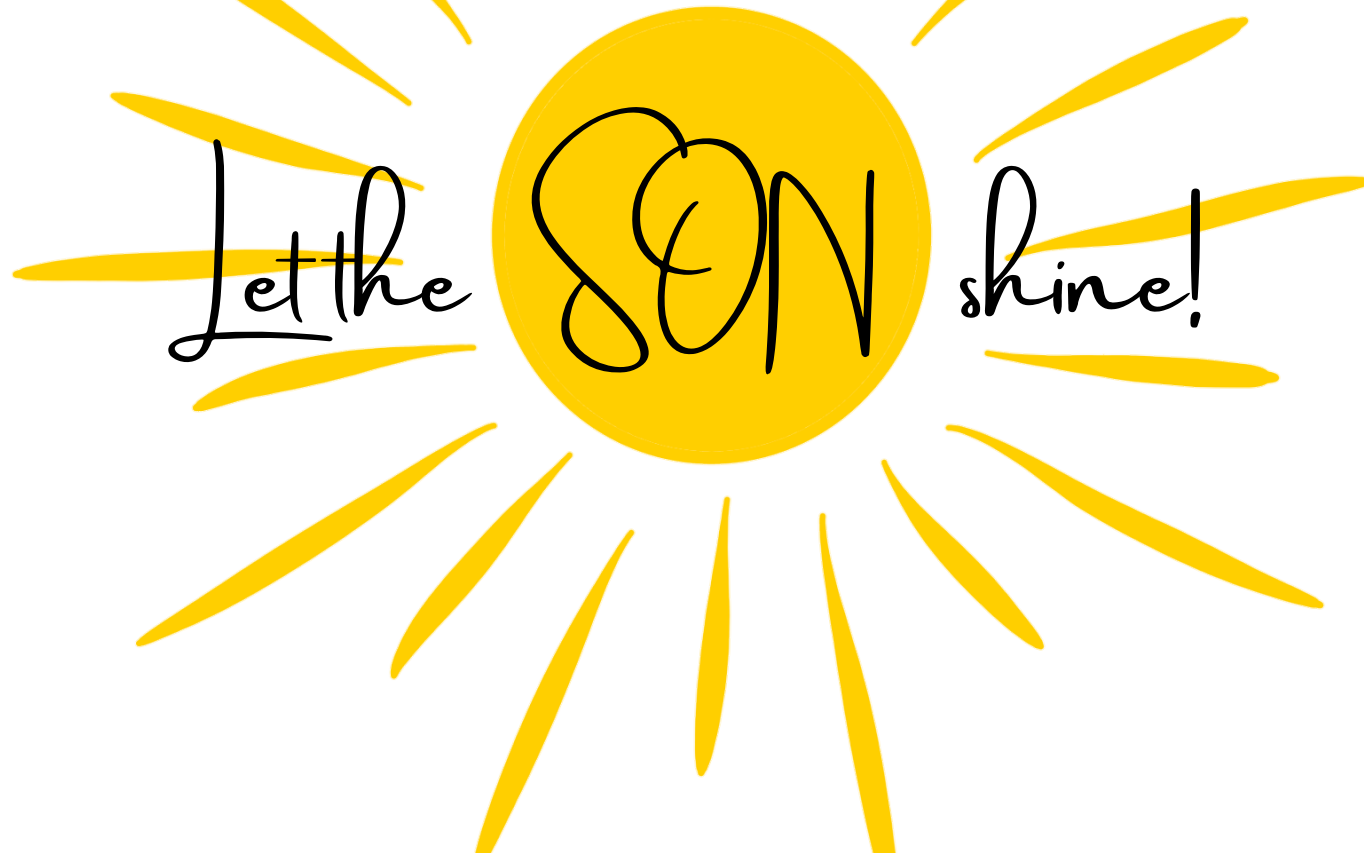

This summer, Miss Alise became certified in an incredible strength training and technique program that will bring a new level of excellence to our dancers. Relative Motion uses specialized pants with different colored panels that are designed to help dancers visually see which muscles to activate in order to improve technique (and prevent injuries). ALL performance team members are required to enroll in the Relative Motion class., and there is a one time fee of \$89 for the class uniform (that can be re-used year after year). We are so excited to bring this new program to Steps to Grace to help our dancers excel in their God-given talents, and to help them prevent dance-related injuries.

Relative Motion is REQUIRED for STG Performance Teams and is highly encouraged for ALL dancers at STG.

At once-a-week classes at STG, Darby's Dancers learn all types of dance in a fun, encouraging atmosphere. Dancers in the program gain confidence, coordination, strength and lifelong friends, all while feeling like a star. DD also provides volunteer opportunities for teens who dance at STG. Our youth volunteers learn important lessons in responsibility and friendship by providing one-on-one assistance to a special needs dancer.

DD classes are taught by volunteer dance instructors and take place in donated studio space. The charitable contributions of youth volunteers, dance instructors, community dance studios and local businesses allow DD to provide dance classes, supplies and costumes to special needs dancers at little to no cost to their parents. Studio Policies, Tuition, Membership & Costume Fees

Withdrawal Policy- When enrolling in classes at STG, you are signing up for the entire year (September 5th-June 7th). If you would like to withdraw from classes, you must notify the office no less than 30 days before the next billing cycle. For example, if your child will be done at the end of February, we need to know BEFORE February 1st so you are not charged tuition in March.

Weather Closures- STG makes every effort to remain open during inclement weather, but we will not put our families or staff at risk in dangerous conditions. We update our Instagram and Facebook pages with any closures, and also contact the local news stations. If we close for bad weather more than TWICE, we will begin offering make-up sessions. Refunds will not be offered for weather closures.

Absence Policy- STG does not offer refunds for any classes missed by your student for vacations, illnesses, or calendar conflicts. We allow students to attend TWO make-up classes in an equal level if they are absent twice. No make-up classes offered beyond that. If there are injuries or other extenuating circumstances, we will will evaluate those on a case-by-case basis.

If a teacher is absent, and a substitute can't be found, we will offer a make-up session for the missed class.

Membership Fee- A yearly STG Membership Fee is charged upon enrollment, along with your first month of tuition. The fee for returning dancers is \$35.00, and new dancers are \$45.00. There is a discount for the second child, and families do not have to pay membership fees for any children beyond the second one.

Tuition Payments-Tuition is collected automatically on the 1st of each month. A credit or debit card must be on file for monthly auto-payments. No exceptions. We do not charge credit card fees. Last full tuition payment will be withdrawn on June 1, 2023.

Tuition Discounts- 5% discounts are offered to first responders, church workers, and members of the military. We also offer sibling discounts of 5% for the second child and beyond. STG offers scholarships and tuition assistance on an as-needed basis. Please contact the office at kelly.stepstograce@gmail.com to have your discount applied, or to discuss our scholarship options. Discounts can't be combined.

Costume Fees

Costume Fees- Costumes are purchased for ALL dancers for the spring recital, with the exception of Mommy & Me classes. Costume fees will be auto-collected in installments to make it easier for our families. Costume fees are NON-REFUNDABLE, no exceptions.

The first installment of costume payments will auto-process on November 15, 2023. The second installment will be processed on February 15, 2024.

If your class only requires ONE payment, it will be auto-processed on February 15, 2024.

If your dancer enrolled AFTER November 15, 2023, their first costume installment will auto-process on February 15, 2024, and the second installment will auto-process on March 15th.

FAQS

When is the first day of class? When is the last day of class? When is the studio closed for holidays?

Classes begin September 5, 2023 and end on June 7th, 2024. STG is closed on Labor Day and Memorial Day. Make-up classes will be offered for our Monday students on November 20, 2023 and March 25, 2024. Classes will take place at their regularly scheduled times. Please check the STG academic calendar for more important dates and holidays. STG is closed 12/22-1/7 for Christmas.

When is recital?

Winter recital is on Sunday, December 10, 2023. Times will be announced at a later date, but the shows will be in the afternoon & evening to allow our families to attend church in the morning.

Spring recital is on Saturday, June 8, 2024. Times will be announced at a later date, but we will have shows going ALL DAY.

Dress rehearsals will be on December 9th for winter shows, and on June 6th & 7th for the spring shows. Times TBA.

What do you do with my STG Membership fee?

Membership fees hold your place in class, and are used to pay for our studio's liability and workman's comp insurance each year, as well as administrative costs incurred between when registration opens and when our 2nd month of tuition payments are collected in October.

How do I watch my child while they are in class?

We have large video monitors for each classroom in our lobby, and each room has a window available for viewing.

Tell me all about costumes!

Bring on the glitter! Fancy costumes are ordered throughout the year for dancers to wear in our JUNE recital. and we stick to simple outfits and accessories for our December show to keep costs down for our families. We have a new way of measuring everyone this year, so STAY TUNED for more info on that. Costume payment schedules can be found on our "policies" page above, and those fees are auto-debited on the due date. ALL enrolled students will participate in both recitals, with the exception of Mommy & Me classes. *Costume fees are non-refundable. Costume suppliers universally do not offer refunds, therefore we are unable to give refunds to our families once costume fees have been paid.*

Why is full tuition charged for December & June, even though classes don't run the entire month?

It takes a significant amount of time to put on a recital, and there are other large costs associated with each show. Our staff puts in more hours during recital week than they do in an entire month of teaching! We don't expect them to work for free, so we compensate them for the extra hours. It's worth it when you see all of the amazing dances on stage, we promise!

What is Rollover Registration?

New this year! Rollover registration allows our current families to pay next year's membership fees in May, which then gives them exclusive access to fall classes before they are released to the public. We have experienced significant growth in the last two years, and some of our veteran families have encountered issues when trying to register for their first-choice classes. We want to make sure everyone has the opportunity to grab what they want before classes are scooped up by new families!
